

PANOLA COUNTY GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON DESIRED FUTURE CONDITIONS OF THE AQUIFER

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of the Panola County Groundwater Conservation District ("District") will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, April 25, 2017 immediately following the Public Hearing for Rule Changes at 5:30 PM in the District office located at 419 West Sabine Street, Carthage, Texas, 75633, to discuss, consider, and finally adopt the Desired Future Condition ("DFC") and the Explanatory Report for the Carrizo-Wilcox Aquifer in Panola County. This action by the District will complete the present round of the joint planning process within Groundwater Management Area 11 ("GMA 11").

The DFC adopted by GMA 11 and now submitted to the District for final adoption for the Carrizo-Wilcox Aquifer in Panola County is **3 (three) feet of drawdown per year**.

All interested members of the public are invited to attend the hearing. Any person who wishes to present comments or other information at the hearing may do so in person, by counsel, or both. Comments may be presented verbally or in written form. However, comments on the DFC should be submitted to the District prior to the date of the hearing in order to provide the District ample time to consider any such comments. Written comments may be submitted to the District's email address or to the District mailing address provided below. Limits may be placed on the amount of time that each person can present verbal comments at the hearing.

The hearing posted in this notice may be recessed from day to day or continued where appropriate. A copy of the proposed DFC and Explanatory Report may be requested by email at district@pcgcd.org or may be reviewed or copied at the District office at 419 West Sabine Street, Carthage, Texas, 75633. Both the DFC and the Explanatory Report are available on the District's website at www.pcgcd.org.
