

# Minutes of Public Hearings on Operating Permit Applications

## Panola County Groundwater Conservation District May 29, 2018

A public hearing was held by the Panola County Groundwater Conservation District Board of Directors at 5:30 p.m. in the District Conference Room on Tuesday, May 29, 2018 on the applications for Operating Permits for Oilfield Water Logistics and Ronny McMillan.

1. The public hearing was called to order by James Browning, Board President, at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday May 29, 2018.
2. Mr. Browning moved into review of the Operating Permit application for Oilfield Water Logistics. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained that Oilfield Water Logistics applied to operate one (1) water well for industrial use. The total usage applied for was 100,000 gallons or 0.31 acre-feet annually.

Based on the presented information and the fact that the application had met all of the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manager recommended that the Board approve the application. Mike Pennington moved and Ray Davis seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit for Oilfield Water Logistics. The motion passed unanimously of those present.


3. Mr. Browning moved into review of the Operating Permit application for Ronny McMillan. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained that Ronny McMillan applied to operate one (1) water well for water sales. The total usage applied for was 63,072,000 gallons or 193.56 acre-feet annually.

Based on the presented information and the fact that the application had met all of the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manager recommended that the Board approve the application. After discussion, Scott Yarnell moved and Ray Davis seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit for Ronny McMillan. The motion passed with seven in favor and one abstaining.

4. With no other items on the agenda, Mr. Browning adjourned the public hearing at 5:35 p.m.
