Minutes of Public Hearings on Operating Permit Applications
June 26, 2018

A public hearing was held by the Panola County Groundwater Conservation District Board of Directors at 5:30 p.m. in the District Conference Room on Tuesday, June 26, 2018 on the applications for Operating Permits for Joe Allison and Cypress Knee Investments.

1. The public hearing was called to order by Mike Pennington, Board Vice President, at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, June 26, 2018.
2. Mr. Pennington moved into review of the Operating Permit application for Joe Allison. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained that Joe Allison applied to operate one (1) water well for water sales. The total usage applied for was 63,072,000 gallons or 193.56 acre-feet annually.

Based on the presented information and the fact that the application had met all of the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manager recommended that the Board approve the application. Danny Reed moved and Ronny McMillan seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit for Joe Allison. The motion passed unanimously of those present.


3. Mr. Pennington moved into review of the Operating Permit application for Cypress Knee Investments. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained that Cypress Knee Investments applied to operate one (1) water well for irrigation. The total usage applied for was 39,420,000 gallons or 120.98 acre-feet annually.

Based on the presented information and the fact that the application had met all of the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manager recommended that the Board approve the application. Danny Reed moved and Jim Payne seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit for Cypress Knee Investments. The motion passed unanimously of those present.

4. With no other items on the agenda, Mr. Pennington adjourned the public hearing at 5:50 p.m.
