Minutes of Public Hearings on Operating Permit Applications  
August 20, 2018

A public hearing was held by the Panola County Groundwater Conservation District Board of Directors at 5:30 p.m. in the District Conference Room at 419 W. Sabine Street, Carthage, Texas 75633 on Monday, August 20, 2018 on the applications for Operating Permits for Teresa Bagley, and BigFoot Energy Services.

1. The public hearing was called to order by James Browning, Board President, at 5:30 p.m. on Monday, August 20, 2018.
2. Mr. Browning moved into review of the Operating Permit application for Teresa Bagley. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained that Teresa Bagley applied to operate one (1) water well for water sales. The total usage applied for was 52,560,000 gallons or 161.30 acre-feet annually.

Based on the presented information and the fact that the application had met all of the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manager recommended that the Board approve the application with the condition that the District may adjust the amount of groundwater authorized to be produced pursuant to this permit based on the impact of the production from this well on the hydrogeologic conditions in the area of the well and/or any existing wells. To assist in this, monthly production reporting is required. Danny Reed moved and Mike Pennington seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit for Teresa Bagley. The motion passed unanimously of those present.

3. Mr. Browning moved into review of the Operating Permit applications for Bigfoot Energy Services. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained that Bigfoot Energy Services applied to operate one (1) water well for industrial use (facility). The total usage applied for was 8,000,000 gallons or 24.56 acre-feet annually.

Based on the presented information and the fact that the application had met all of the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manager recommended that the Board approve the application. Scott Yarnell moved and Mike Pennington seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit for Bigfoot Energy. The motion passed unanimously of those present.

4. Mr. Browning moved into review of the Operating Permit application for Bigfoot Energy Services. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained that Bigfoot Energy Services applied to operate one (1) water well for water sales & facility use. The total usage applied for was 71,935,140 gallons or 220.76 acre-feet annually.

Based on the presented information and the fact that the application had met all of the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manager recommended that the Board approve the application. Ray Davis moved and Ronny McMillan seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit for Bigfoot Energy Services. The motion passed unanimously of those present.

5. With no other items on the agenda, Mr. Browning adjourned the public hearing at 7:39 p.m.
