Minutes of Public Hearings on Operating Permit Applications
September 25, 2018

A public hearing was held by the Panola County Groundwater Conservation District Board of Directors at 5:30 p.m. in the District Conference Room at 419 W. Sabine Street, Carthage, Texas 75633 on Tuesday, September 25, 2018 on the applications for Operating Permits for Don Vaughan and Robert Tiller.

1. The public hearing was called to order by James Browning, Board President, at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, September 25, 2018.
2. Mr. Browning moved into review of the Operating Permit applications for Don Vaughan. He asked the Office Manager to present the applications. The Office Manager then explained that Don Vaughan applied to operate two (2) water wells for water sales. The proposed total usage for each well was 1,000,000 gallons or 3.07 acre-feet annually.


Based on the presented information and the fact that the applications had met all of the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the Office Manager recommended that the Board approve the applications. Danny Reed moved and Scott Yarnell seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permits for Don Vaughan. The motion passed unanimously.


3. Mr. Browning moved into review of the Operating Permit application for Robert Tiller. He asked the Office Manager to present the application. The Office Manager then explained that Robert Tiller applied to operate one (1) water well for water sales. The total usage applied for was 57,816,000 gallons or 177.43 acre-feet annually.

Based on the presented information and the fact that the application had met all of the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the Office Manager recommended that the Board approve the application. Scott Yarnell moved and Ronny McMillan seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit for Robert Tiller. The motion passed unanimously.

4. With no other items on the agenda, Mr. Browning adjourned the public hearing at 5:34 p.m.
