
1. The public hearing was called to order by James Browning, Board President, at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, October 23, 2018.
2. Mr. Browning moved into review of the Operating Permit application for Cindy Crooks. He asked the Interim General Manager to present the application. The Interim General Manager then explained that Cindy Crooks applied to operate one (1) water well for water sales. The proposed total usage was 12,000,000 gallons or 36.83 acre-feet annually.

Based on the presented information and the fact that the application had met all of the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the Interim General Manager recommended that the Board approve the application. Scott Yarnell moved and Ray Davis seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit for Cindy Crooks. The motion passed unanimously.

3. With no other items on the agenda, Mr. Browning adjourned the public hearing at 5:34 p.m.
