1. The public hearing was called to order by Mike Pennington, Board President, at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, February 26, 2019.
2. Mr. Pennington moved into review of the Operating Permit application for Johnny Williams. He asked the General Manager to present the applications. The General Manager then explained that Johnny Williams applied to operate one (1) water well for agricultural use (poultry). The proposed total usage for this well was 8,000,000 gallons or 24.56 acre-feet annually.


Based on the presented information and the fact that the applications had met all of the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manager recommended that the Board approve the application. Scott Yarnell moved and Danny Reed seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit for Johnny Williams. The motion passed unanimously.
