Minutes of Public Hearings on Operating Permit Applications
March 26, 2019

A public hearing was held by the Panola County Groundwater Conservation District Board of Directors at 5:30 p.m. in the District Conference Room at 419 W. Sabine Street, Carthage, Texas 75633 on Tuesday, March 26, 2019 on the application for an Operating Permit for Danny Kirkland and D. Mills Farm Partnership, LLC.

1. The public hearing was called to order by Mike Pennington, Board President, at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, March 26, 2019.
2. Mr. Pennington moved into review of the Operating Permit applications for Danny Kirkland. He asked the General Manager to present the applications. The General Manager then explained that Danny Kirkland applied to operate four (4) water wells for commercial use (water sales). The proposed total usage for well 1 and well 2 is 13,140,000 gallons or 40.33 acre-feet annually per well and the proposed total usage for well 3 and well 4 is 15,768,000 gallons or 48.39 acre-feet annually per well.


Based on the presented information and the fact that the applications had met all of the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manager recommended that the Board approve the application. Danny Reed moved and Ronny McMillan seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit for Danny Kirkland. The motion passed unanimously.

3. Mr. Pennington moved into review of the Operating Permit applications for D. Mills Farm Partnership, LLC. He asked the General Manager to present the applications. The General Manager then explained that D. Mills Farms and Partnership, LLC applied to drill and operate one (1) water well for water sales. The proposed total usage for ~~each~~^{the} well was 73,584,000 gallons or 225.83 acre-feet annually.

Based on the presented information and the fact that the applications had met all of the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manger recommended that the Board approve the applications. Scott Yarnell moved, and Denzel Harrison seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permits for D. Mills Farm and Partnership LLC. The motion passed unanimously of those present.

4. With no other items on the agenda, Mr. Pennington adjourned the public hearing at 5:31 p.m.
