1. The Public Hearing was called to order by Mike Pennington, Board President, at 5:32 p.m. on Tuesday, August 6, 2019.
2. Mr. Pennington moved into review of the Operating/Export Permit application for Rockcliff Energy Mgt, LLC. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained that Rockcliff Energy Mgt, LLC applied to operate three (3) water wells for out of county export. The proposed total usage for the well was 70,000,000 gallons or 214.82 acre-feet annually.


