1. The Public Hearing was called to order by Larry Dorman, Board Vice President, at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, June 25, 2019.
2. Mr. Dorman moved into review of the Operating Permit application for D. Mills Farm Partnership, LLC. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained that D. Mills Farms and Partnership, LLC applied to operate one (1) water well for water sales. The proposed total usage for the well was 78,314,400 gallons or 240.34 acre-feet annually.

Based on the presented information and the fact that the application had met all the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manger recommended that the Board approve the application. Danny Reed moved, and Denzel Harrison seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit for D. Mills Farm and Partnership LLC. The motion passed unanimously of those present.
