2. Public hearing for Operating Permit Applications:

Joe Harris, located at 1855 FM 31 N, DeBerry, TX 75639 applied to operate three (3) water wells located near FM 124 and CR 326 for the purpose of water sales. The potential maximum annual groundwater production from these wells is shown below:

4. Public hearing for Operating Permit Applications:

BTA ETG Gathering, located at 1100 Louisiana St., Houston, TX 77002 applied to operate one 6-inch casing water well located at 480 PR 8015, Carthage, TX 75633, for industrial use. The potential maximum annual groundwater production from this well is 26,280,000 gallons or 80.65 acre-feet annually for the water well at the estimated rate of withdrawal of 50 gallons per minute.

The total usage applied for is 26,280,000 gallons or 80.65-acre feet annually.

At any time during the meeting and in compliance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Government Code, Vernon's Texas Codes, Annotated, the Panola County Groundwater Conservation District Board may meet in executive session on any of the above agenda items for consultation concerning attorney-client matters (§551.071), deliberation regarding real property (§551.072), deliberation regarding prospective gift (§551.073), personnel matters (§551.074), and deliberation regarding security devices (§551.076). Any subject discussed in executive session may be subject to action during an open meeting.
