1. The Public Hearing was called to order by Mike Pennington, Board President, at 5:30.m. on Tuesday, October 22, 2019.
2. Mr. Pennington moved into review of the Operating application for Toby Clabaugh. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained that Toby Clabaugh applied to operate one (1) water well for livestock use. The proposed total usage for the well was 16,848,000 gallons or 51.71 acre-feet annually.

Based on the presented information and the fact that the application had met all the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manger recommended that the Board approve the application. Scott Yarnell moved, and Denzel Harrison seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit for Toby Clabaugh. The motion passed unanimously of those present.
