Minutes of Public Hearings on Operating Permit Applications
December 17, 2019

A Public Hearing was held by the Panola County Groundwater Conservation District Board of Directors at 5:35 p.m. in the District Conference Room at 419 W. Sabine Street, Carthage, Texas 75633 on Tuesday, December 17, 2019 on the applications for Operating Permits for Timothy Alexander, BTA ETG Gathering and Gemini Midstream.

1. The Public Hearing was called to order by Mike Pennington, Board President, at 5:35 pm. on Tuesday, December 17, 2019.
2. Mr. Pennington moved into review of the Operating Permit application for Timothy Alexander. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained that Timothy Alexander applied to operate one (1) water well for irrigation use. The proposed total usage for the well was 8,935,200 gallons or 27.42 acre-feet annually.

Based on the presented information and the fact that the application had met all the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manger recommended that the Board approve the application. Danny Reed moved, and Ray Davis seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit for Timothy Alexander. The motion passed unanimously of those present.

3. Mr. Pennington moved into review of the Operating Permit application for BTA ETG Gathering. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained that BTA ETG Gathering applied to operate one (1) water well for industrial use. The proposed total usage for the well was 39,420,000 gallons or 120.97 acre-feet annually.

Based on the presented information and the fact that the application had met all the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manger recommended that the Board approve the application. Scott Yarnell moved, and Danny Reed seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit for BTA ETG Gathering. The motion passed unanimously of those present.

4. Mr. Pennington moved into review of the Operating Permit application for Gimini Midstream. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained that Gemini Midstream applied to operate one (1) water well for industrial use. The proposed total usage for the well was 2,920,000 gallons or 8.96 acre-feet annually.

Based on the presented information and the fact that the application had met all the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manger recommended that the Board approve the application. Ray Davis moved, and Scott Yarnell seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit for Gemini Midstream. The motion passed unanimously of those present.

5. With no other items on the agenda, Mr. Pennington adjourned the public hearing at 5:40 p.m.
