

1. The Public Hearing was called to order by Mike Pennington, Board President, at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, January 28, 2020.
2. Mr. Pennington moved into review of the Operating Permit application for Jimmy Jones. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained that Jimmy Jones applied to operate one (1) water well for irrigation use. The proposed total usage for the well was 48,355,200 gallons or 148.40 acre-feet annually.


Based on the presented information and the fact that the application had met all the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manger recommended that the Board approve the application. Ray Davis moved, and Bud Worley seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit for Jimmy Jones. The motion passed unanimously of those present.
