### PUBLIC HEARING AGENDA - PERMITS

1. Call to order.
2. Public hearing for Operating Permit Applications:

Eric Pellham, located at 5652 HWY 124, Beckville, TX 75631, applied to operate one (1) water well located near US HWY 79 S, Carthage, TX 75633 for water sales. The potential maximum annual groundwater production from the well is 22,600,800 gallons or 69.36 acre-feet annually for the water well at the estimated rate of withdrawal of 43 gallons per minute.

The total usage applied for is 22,600,800 gallons or 69.36-acre feet annually.

3. Joe Harris, located at 1855 FM 31 N, DeBerry, TX 75639, applied to operate two (2) water wells located near CR 322, DeBerry, TX 75639 for water sales. The potential maximum annual groundwater production from each well is:  
Harris Drum #1 – 13,140,000 gallons or 40.32 acre-feet annually for the water well at the estimated rate of withdrawal of 25 gallons per minute.  
Harris Drum #2 – 13,140,000 gallons or 40.32 acre-feet annually for the water well at the estimated rate of withdrawal of 25 gallons per minute.

The combined total usage applied for is 26,280,000 gallons or 80.65-acre feet annually.

4. C.G. Cline, located at 9922 US Hwy 79 N, DeBerry, TX 75639, applied to operate one (1) water well located at 9906 US Hwy 79 N, DeBerry, TX 75639 for water sales. The potential maximum annual groundwater production from the well is 31,536,000 gallons or 96.79 acre-feet annually for the water well at the estimated rate of withdrawal of 60 gallons per minute.

The total usage applied for is 31,536,000 gallons or 96.79-acre feet annually.


#### Certification
