Minutes of Public Hearings on Operating Permit Applications  
August 27, 2019

A Public Hearing was held by the Panola County Groundwater Conservation District Board of Directors at 5:30 p.m. in the District Conference Room at 419 W. Sabine Street, Carthage, Texas 75633 on Tuesday, August 27, 2019 on the application for an Operating Permit for Travis Wall, Rockcliff Energy Mgt, LLC and Robert Tiller.

1. The Public Hearing was called to order by Larry Dorman, Board Vice President, at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, August 27, 2019.
2. Mr. Dorman moved into review of the Operating application for Travis Wall. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained that Travis Wall applied to operate one (1) water well for domestic / irrigation use. The proposed total usage for the well was 15,768,000 gallons or 48.40 acre-feet annually.

Based on the presented information and the fact that the application had met all the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manger recommended that the Board approve the application. Scott Yarnell moved, and Ronny McMillan seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit for Travis Wall. The motion passed unanimously of those present.

3. Mr. Dorman moved into review of the Operating/Export Permit application for Rockcliff Energy Mgt, LLC. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained that Rockcliff Energy Mgt, LLC applied to operate three (3) water wells for out of county export. The proposed total usage for the well was 173,600,000 gallons or 532.76 acre-feet annually.

Based on the presented information and the fact that the application had met all the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manger recommended that the Board approve the application. Danny Reed moved, and Denzel Harrison seconded the motion to approve the Operating/Export Permit for Rockcliff Energy Mgt, LLC. The motion passed unanimously of those present.


4. Mr. Dorman moved into review of the Operating application for Robert Tiller. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained that Robert Tiller applied to operate one (1) water well for irrigation use. The proposed total usage for the well was 3,240,000 gallons or 9.94 acre-feet annually.

Based on the presented information and the fact that the application had met all the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manger recommended that the Board approve the application. Scott Yarnell moved, and Todd Malone seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit for Robert Tiller. The motion passed unanimously of those present.

5. With no other items on the agenda, Mr. Dorman adjourned the public hearing at 5:40 p.m.
