1. The Public Hearing was called to order by Mike Pennington, Board President, at 5:32 p.m. on Tuesday, July 28, 2020.
2. Mr. Pennington moved into review of the Operating Permit application for Eric Pellham. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained that Eric Pellham applied to drill and operate a water wells for water sales. The proposed total usage for the well is 22,600,800 gallons or 69.36 acre-feet annually

Based on the presented information for the applicant and the fact that the application had met all the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manger recommended that the Board approve the application. Todd Malone moved, and Bud Worley, seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit. The motion passed unanimously of those present.

3. Mr. Pennington moved into review of the Operating Permit applications for Joe Harris. He asked the General Manager to present the applications. The General Manager then explained that Joe Harris applied to drill and operate two (2) water wells for water sales. The proposed combine total usage for the wells are 26,280,000 gallons or 80.65acre-feet annually

Based on the presented information for the applicant and the fact that the application had met all the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manger recommended that the Board approve the applications. Ray Davis moved, and Ronny McMillan, seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permits. The motion passed unanimously of those present

4. Mr. Pennington moved into review of the Operating Permit application for C.G. Cline. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained

that C.G. Cline applied to drill and operate a water well for water sales. The proposed total usage for the well is 31,536,0000 gallons or 96.79 acre-feet annually

5. Based on the presented information for the applicant and the fact that the application had met all the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manger recommended that the Board approve the application. Ray Davis moved, and Bud Worley, seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit. The motion passed unanimously of those present
6. With no other items on the agenda, Mr. Pennington adjourned the public hearing at 5:37 p.m.
