1. The Public Hearing was called to order by Mike Pennington, Board President, at 5:33 p.m. on Tuesday, June 23, 2020.
2. Mr. Pennington moved into review of the Operating Permit application for Greg Ransom. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained that Greg Ransom applied to drill and operate two (2) water wells for poultry use. The proposed combined total usage for the wells are 78,314,400 gallons or 240.34 acre-feet annually

Based on the presented information for the applicant and the fact that the application had met all the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manger recommended that the Board approve the applications. Scott Yarnell moved, and Danny Reed seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit. The motion passed unanimously of those present.
