A Public Hearing was held by the Panola County Groundwater Conservation District Board of Directors at 5:30 p.m. in the District Conference Room at 419 W. Sabine Street, Carthage, Texas 75633 on Tuesday, August 25, 2020 on the application for an Operating Permit for Gulf South Pipeline Co., LLC and Enterprise Products.

1. The Public Hearing was called to order by Mike Pennington, Board President, at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, August 25, 2020.
2. Mr. Pennington moved into review of the Operating Permit application for Gulf South Pipeline., LLC. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained that Gulf South Pipeline Co., LLC applied to operate one (1) water well for facility use. The proposed total usage for the well is 9,000,000 gallons or 27.61 acre-feet annually

Based on the presented information for the applicant and the fact that the application had met all the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manger recommended that the Board approve the application. Danny Reed moved, and Ray Davis seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit. The motion passed unanimously of those present.

3. Mr. Pennington moved into review of the Operating Permit application for Enterprise Products. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained that Enterprise Products applied to operate one (1) water well for facility use. The proposed total usage for the well is 15,000,000 gallons or 30.69 acre-feet annually

Based on the presented information for the applicant and the fact that the application had met all the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manger recommended that the Board approve the application. Denzel Harrison moved, and Ronny McMillan seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit. The motion passed unanimously of those present.

4. With no other items on the agenda, Mr. Pennington adjourned the public hearing at 5:36 p.m.
