1. The Public Hearing was called to order by Mike Pennington, Board President, at 5:32 p.m. on Tuesday, December 15, 2020.
2. Mr. Pennington moved into review of the Operating Permit application for Daniel Jansen. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained that Daniel Jansen applied to operate one (1) water well for Water Sales. The proposed total usage for the well is 47,304,000 gallons or 145.17 acre-feet annually.

Based on the presented information for the applicant and the fact that the application had met all the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manger recommended that the Board approve the application with the stipulation that the pumping rate will be reduced if the surrounding registered water wells show a 25% drop in water levels. Danny Reed moved, and Scott Yarnell seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit. The motion passed unanimously of those present.

3. With no other items on the agenda, Mr. Pennington adjourned the public hearing at 5:50 p.m.
