


1. The Public Hearing was called to order by Mike Pennington, Board President, at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, March 23, 2021.
2. Mr. Pennington moved into review of the Operating Permit application for Davis Elite Energy Service. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained that Davis Elite Energy Services applied to operate one (1) water well for facility use. The proposed total usage for the well is 8,000,000 gallons or 24.55 acre-feet annually.

Based on the presented information for the applicant and the fact that the application had met all the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manger recommended that the Board approve the application. Danny Reed moved, and Scott Yarnell seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit. The motion passed unanimously of those present.

3. With no other items on the agenda, Mr. Pennington adjourned the public hearing at 5:42 p.m.
