

1. The Public Hearing was called to order by Mike Pennington, Board President, at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, May 25, 2021.
2. Mr. Pennington moved into review of the Operating Permit application for Joe Harris. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained that Joe Harris applied to operate one (1) water well for water sales. The proposed total usage for the well is 31,356,000 gallons or 96.22 acre-feet annually.


