1. The Public Hearing was called to order by Mike Pennington, Board President, at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, June 22, 2021.
2. Mr. Pennington moved into review of the Operating Permit application for Jeremy Green. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained that Jeremy Green, on behalf of Iron Mountain, had applied to operate one (1) water well for facility use. The proposed total usage for the well is 9,460,800 gallons or 29.03 acre-feet annually.


