


1. The regular board meeting was called to order by Mike Pennington, Board President, at 5:30 p.m.
2. Bud Worley conducted the invocation.
3. There was no public comment at the November 17, 2021 Regular Board Meeting.
4. After reviewing the October 19, 2021 Regular Board Meeting Minutes, Ray Davis moved, and Jody Harris seconded the motion to approve the minutes. The motion passed unanimously.
5. After reviewing the 2022 Holiday Schedule, Rodger McLane moved and Bud Worley seconded the motion to approve the Schedule as presented. The motion passed unanimously.
6. The General Manager gave routine office updates. There was no action taken.
7. District staff provided updates on monitor wells, rain gauges, and other District field work. The monthly monitor deep well readings showed a water level change of 0.0 feet in the last month. The shallow monitor well water levels showed a decline of 0.3 feet in the last month. The net groundwater level change in October 2021 was down 0.1 feet. Panola County's recorded rainfall average for October was 1.96 inches. The historical precipitation average for October is 4.12 inches. As of November 9th 2021, there is moderate/severe drought in Panola County according to the U.S. Drought Monitor for Texas. In the last month, there have been significant drawdowns near a frac pond in the DeBerry area, while water levels have been mostly stable in other monitored areas.

8. After reviewing the district's expenditures from October 20, 2021 to November 17, 2021, Rodger McLane moved, and Jody Harris seconded the motion to approve the expenditures as presented. The motion passed unanimously.
9. The Board did not enter into executive session at the November 23, 2021 Regular Board Meeting at 5:33p.m.
10. No action was taken.
11. Next meeting date is set for December 28, 2021.
12. With no further business, Bud Worley moved, and Ray Davis seconded the motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion passed unanimously of those present, and the meeting was adjourned at 6:07p.m.
