
1. The regular board meeting was called to order by Mike Pennington, Board President, at 6:45 p.m.
2. Bud Worley conducted the invocation.
3. There was no public comment at the February 22, 2022, Regular Board Meeting.
4. After reviewing the January 25, 2022, Regular Board Meeting Minutes, Ray Davis moved, and Jody Harris seconded the motion to approve the minutes. The motion passed unanimously.
5. The General Manager gave routine office updates. There was no action taken.
6. District staff provided updates on monitor wells, rain gauges, and other District field work. The monthly monitor deep well readings showed a water level decline of 0.2 feet in the last month. The shallow monitor well water levels showed decline of 0.2 feet in the last month. Panola County's recorded rainfall average for January was 0.68 inches. The historical precipitation average for January is 4.28 inches. The cumulative precipitation total for 2022 was 0.68 inches. As of February 22, 2022, Panola County is in Severe Drought according to the U.S. Drought Monitor for Texas. In the last month, there have been no significant drawdowns near frac pond, and water levels have been mostly stable in other areas.

7. After reviewing the District's expenditures from January 24, 2022, to February 18, 2022, Danny Reed moved, and Bud Worley seconded the motion to approve the payment of expenditures as presented. The motion passed unanimously.
8. The Board did not enter into executive session at the February 22, 2022, meeting.
9. No action to be taken.
10. The next board meeting was set for March 29, 2022. No action was taken.
11. With no further business, Bud Worley moved, and Rodger McLane seconded the motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion passed unanimously of those present, and the meeting was adjourned at 7:12 p.m.
