

1. The regular board meeting was called to order by Mike Pennington, Board President, at 5:58p.m.
2. Jody Harris conducted the invocation.
3. There was no public comment at the April 25, 2023 Regular Board Meeting.
4. After reviewing the March 28, 2023 Public Hearing Meeting Minutes, Todd Malone moved, and Bud Worley seconded the motion to approve the minutes. The motion passed unanimously.
5. After reviewing the March 28, 2023 Regular Board Meeting Minutes, Bud Worley moved, and Todd Malone seconded the motion to approve the minutes. The motion passed unanimously.
6. The General Manager gave routine office updates. There was no action taken.
7. District staff provided updates on monitor wells, rain gauges, and other District field work. The monthly monitor deep well readings showed a water level increase of .06 feet in the last month. The shallow monitor well water levels showed an increase of .21 feet in the last month. Panola County's recorded rainfall average for March was 3.36 inches. The historical precipitation average for March is 4.11 inches. The cumulative precipitation total for 2023 is 13.69 inches. As of April, 2023, Panola County is in a No Drought status according to the U.S. Drought Monitor for Texas. In the last month, there have been no significant drawdowns near frac ponds, and water levels have slightly increased in other areas.

8. After reviewing the district's expenditures from March 25, 2023 to April 21, 2023, John Burgess moved, and Corey Turner seconded the motion to approve the expenditures as presented. The motion passed unanimously.
9. The Board did not enter into executive session at the April 25, 2023, meeting.
10. No action to be taken.
11. Next meeting date is set for May 23, 2023.
12. With no further business, Jody Harris moved, and Bud Worley seconded the motion to adjourn the meeting. The motion passed unanimously of those present, and the meeting was adjourned at 6:12 p.m.
