- 1. The Public Hearing was called to order by Mike Pennington, Board President, at 5:32 p.m. on Tuesday, June 27, 2023.
- 2. Mr. Pennington moved into review of the Operating Permit application for Chris Adams. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained that Chris Adams applied to operate two (2) water wells for water sales. The total combined usage applied for is 47,304,000 gallons or 145.17 acre-feet annually.

Based on the presented information for the applicant and the fact that the application had met all the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manger recommended that the Board approve the application. Danny Reed moved, and Cory Turner seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit. The motion passed unanimously of those present.

3. Mr. Pennington moved into review of the Operating Permit application for Socagee Midstream Gas Services LLC. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained that Socagee Midstream Gas Services LLC, applied to operate one (1) water wells for industrial use. The total usage applied for is 13,140,000 gallons or 40.33 acrefeet annually.

Based on the presented information for the applicant and the fact that the application had met all the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manger recommended that the Board approve the application. Charles Foster moved, and Mike Roquemore seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit. The motion passed unanimously of those present.

4. With no other items on the agenda, Mr. Pennington adjourned the public hearing at 5:37 p.m.
