

1. The Public Hearing was called to order by Mike Pennington, Board President, at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, May 23, 2023.
2. Mr. Pennington moved into review of the Operating Permit application for Jason Griffin. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained that Jason Griffin applied to operate one (1) water well for water sales. The total usage applied for is 14,000,000 gallons or 42.96 acre-feet annually.

Based on the presented information for the applicant and the fact that the application had met all the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manger recommended that the Board approve the application. Danny Reed moved, and Mike Roquemore seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit. The motion passed unanimously of those present.
