1. The Public Hearing was called to order by Mike Pennington, Board President, at 5:38 p.m. on Tuesday, July 30, 2024.

The General Manager then explained that Harris applied to operate one (1) water well for water sales use. The total combined usage applied for is 52,560,000 gallons or 161.3 acre-feet annually.
