1. The Public Hearing was called to order by Mike Pennington, Board President, at 5:34 p.m. on Tuesday, August 27, 2024.
2. Mr. Pennington moved into review of the Operating Permit application for Lucky W Ranch. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained that Lucky W Ranch applied to operate one (1) water well for agriculture (livestock) use. The total combined usage applied for is 10,000,000 gallons or 30,69 acre-feet annually. Based on the presented information for the applicant and the fact that the application had met all the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manager recommended that the Board approve the application. Todd Malone moved, and Mike Roquemore seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit. The motion carried unanimously
