



1. The Public Hearing was called to order by Mike Pennington, Board President, at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, December 17, 2024.
2. Mr. Pennington moved into review of the Operating Permit application for Enterprise Products. He asked the General Manager to present the application. The General Manager then explained that Enterprise Products applied to operate one (1) water well for industrial (facility) use. The total combined usage applied for is 7,884,000 gallons or 24.20 acre-feet annually. Based on the presented information for the applicant and the fact that the application had met all the requirements of the District Rules and Chapter 36, TWC, the General Manager recommended that the Board approve the application. Charles Foster moved, and Charles Worley seconded the motion to approve the Operating Permit. The motion carried unanimously
3. With no other items on the agenda Mr. Pennington adjourned the public hearing at 5:37 P.M.
