Minutes of Public Hearing on
Operating Permit Applications
December 16, 2025

A Public Hearing was held by the Panola County Groundwater Conservation District Board of Directors 5:30 p.m., in the District Conference Room at 419 W. Sabine Street, Carthage, Texas 75633 on Tuesday, December 16, 2025, on the application for an Operating Permit for Rock Hill Water Supply.

1. The Public Hearing was called to order by Mike Pennington, Board President at 5:30 p.m. on Tuesday, December 16, 2025.
2. There was no public comment at the December 16, 2025 Public Hearing-Permit meeting.
3. Mr. Pennington moved into review of the Operating Permit application for Rock Hill Water Supply. He asked the General Manager to present the applications. The General Manager explained that Rock Hill Water Supply, of 220 CR 212, Beckville, TX 75361 applied for a permit to operate one (1) water well located at or near County Road 302 & US Hwy 59, Carthage, TX 75633 for public water supply use. The potential maximum annual groundwater production from this well, in gallons and estimated maximum rate of withdrawal in gallons per minute (gpm) are shown below:


<u>Well Name</u>	<u>Potential Maximum Annual Production</u>	<u>GPM</u>
Rock Hill Well 3	78,840,000	150

The total usage applied for is 78,840,000 gallons or 242-acre feet annually at the rate of 150 gallons per minute, per well.

Based upon the General Manager's findings that the application meets the requirements of the District's Rules and Chapter 36 of the Texas Water Code, Mike Roquemore moved and Heath Hayes seconded the motion to approve the issuance of an Operating Permit Rock Hill Water Supply, for a total of 78,840,000 gallons per year or 242 acre-feet of groundwater production annually at a rate of 150 gallons per minute, per well. The motion passed unanimously.

4. With no other items on the agenda, the meeting was adjourned at 5:32 P.M.
